The Passion Week—Part II

Introduction:

If Sunday, then why Friday? Monday and Tuesday. In other words, the crowd at Christ's triumphal entry receives Jesus as their king, but on Friday (just 5 days later), the cries have turned to "Crucify him!" This was so primarily because they were looking to follow Christ on their terms, not His. His terms for receiving Him as king are spelled out in the Temple on Monday and Tuesday. Sunday is about Messianic *presentation*; Monday and Tuesday are about Messianic *proclamation*.

Let us pray now to ask the Spirit of God to make known to us the person and work of Jesus Christ.

2. *Theological objective (doctrine)*: to understand the significance of this week's events
3. *Practical objective (devotion)*: to consider a sensible response in light of this week's events
