Colossians 3:1-4

At what points in time have you set your mind firmly on things above, not things on earth? What were the circumstances? What were your thoughts? Excellent effort.

On what specific occasions did you set your mind on earthly things? What was the setting? What was your thought process?

What does being raised up with Christ have to do with your desires? How are your thoughts related to Christ and His present position?

In what sense have you died? What does it mean to have died? What effect has this had on your motives in life?

Is your life hidden with Christ in God? How so?

How would a habit of the thinking of verses 1 and 2 result in the manner of life described in verse 3?

What could you change in your manner of thinking which would result in being a better doer of the Word in relation to these 3 verses? Are you willing to commit yourself to this new way? If so, tell the Lord about it here.

If you follow through with your plan as just stated, what would you expect the scene described in verse 4 to be? What interaction would you want to have with Christ? What would the revelation of your life in Him include?
