## James 4:1-10

What are the specific pleasures that wage war in your members?
What conflicts result inside you?
Commonly, what biblical priorities are sacrificed for these idols?
What wrong motives are connected with your pleasures?
How could these "pleasures" be changed from being idols (sinful) to being blessings from God to be enjoyed?
What is God's view of believers putting pleasure above obeying God? How does this affect our relationship with God? How important is this?
If you turn away from the pride of friendship with the world and pursue humble obedience to God, what will change? How will God respond? Will you make this commitment?
How would you summarize what is being described in verses 7-10? What title would you give to this section?
Of the 8 specific actions prescribed, which 3 are most important for you to do in relation to your idols?
