

Putting it All in Perspective

2 Timothy 2:8-10

Take time to remember Jesus Christ. As is the focus in communion, consider the Lord now. What images do you recall? What words of His come to mind? What actions do you remember? Record them here.

Think about our Lord resurrected now. Give thanks for all He is and has done. Worship Him because the Father has exalted Him. Remember His victory over death and over hell.

Also take time to confess any unconfessed sin. Give thanks for the access you have to the Father through Jesus Christ. Give thanks for the certain forgiveness via His blood.

Do you suffer for the Gospel? Do you ever avoid opposition by staying quiet about Jesus Christ, your relationship with Him, or His Word? If "no" and "yes," include a commitment to Him to pursue honoring Him in these opportunities.

For what does Paul endure all things? What storms have you endured for the sake of ministry? Excellent work. Have you sometimes held back? What are your current battles---what must you stand against, to endure for the sake of those you serve? Remember Jesus Christ, risen; remember that each person in your life will live eternally somewhere. Purpose to endure.
