Pure People Doing Good Deeds

Titus 2:11-15

What are the results of salvation in terms of actions, desires and thinking?
Titus 2:11-12 What words, ways, motives and ideas of yours are God-honoring results of salvation? Which are not?
Note that Titus 2:13 describes Christ as not only Savior, but God. How does the hope of seeing the Lord face to face affect our actions, goals and thoughts?
Why did Christ come to us? Who is doing the work of purifying us? Why aren't we pure?
Would your friends consider you zealous for good deeds? If not, what would they consider you zealous for?
Titus 2:14 describes us being delivered from lawless deeds and zealous for good deeds. How are these related to each other? Pray for God's work in delivering you from lawless deeds to good deeds. Pray that He would give you a zeal, so you could speak with authority and let no one disregard you (2:15).
