

What to do When You Sin?

1 John 1:8-9

Does the word "we" in 1 John 1:8-10 refer to believers in Christ, to unbelievers or to mankind in general (cf. 1 John 2:4; 5:10)?

There is a contrast here between those who deny sin and those who confess sin. What does God promise to those who confess their sin?

What does it mean for God to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness?

When does verse nine say this promise takes affect?

Which describes you, someone who denys their sin or someone who confesses their sin? Is confession of sins your practice? If so, when, where and how?

Please take time to continue the practice of confessing your sins to God and be certain to express thanksgiving that Christ has forgiven you and cleansed your from all unrighteousness.
