Set Apart To Be Pure

John 17:15-21

For what did Jesus pray for you? Do you view problems in a similar way?
In John 16:33, Jesus said "These things I have spoken to you, that in Me you may have peace. In the world you have tribulation, but take courage; I have overcome the world." What is the reason He gave in verse 15, to take courage in the midst of the storm?
Jesus viewed believers as being of a different nature than unbelievers. Do you? What demonstrates this view in your life?
The Greek Word for "sanctify" (Hagiazo) means, "to set apart." It is from the root word meaning to purify or to make Holy. The Word of God is the tool He chooses to use to make us Holy, to cause our "not of the world" nature to become practice. What is your commitment to the study of God's Word?
How did Jesus remain pure? How did that allow us to be Holy?
