**What Do You Have in Common with a Murderer?
Matthew 5:21-26

1. Anger toward a brother.

We are as equally guilty as a murderer and deserve justice.

The Pharisees would look at others and say how glad they are that they were not like the murderers, adulterers, and tax gatherers. Most people today are of the same mind set. They look at the atrocities around them and say how glad they are not to be like that.

The sister sin of murder is anger toward a brother. This shows that we are equally guilty. There are none that are righteous.

2. Anger of a brother toward you.

Not only are we to be concerned with the anger that we have toward another but also be concerned about another's anger toward us. If someone has something against you, SETTLE it!
