Introduction.

Jesus has asked us to follow Him. If we are following, we must do the things Christ has told us to do.

Judas is an example of the premier hypocrite; three years with Christ and the other disciples and when Jesus said, "Tonight one of you will betray me," the other disciples had no idea who it would be.

1. We need to give.

But not to be seen of men. To give to be seen is taking, like making a purchase. They have received all they will.

We are to give without self-serving motives.

2. We need to give without hypocrisy.

3. We need to give with expectation.

2 Corinthians 9:6-8, "...you will have abundance for every good deed." Heart attitude, give to meet every need. Giving sets us free. Free from a greedy consuming appetite.
