**Romans 5: 1-11**  
**Part 2**

Introduction - The security of the believer is the “fruit” of justification by faith. I Peter 1:3-5, “...protected by the power of God.”

Body

1. Peace with God: Based upon Christ’s finished work!
2. Standing in Grace.
3. Hope of the Glory of God.

Excited about our future, exult, rejoice, boast! Why? Because it is certain!

One day we will be in the presence of God, seeing Jesus face to face, separated from the presence of sin. Be excited about this hope for it is sure.

2 Cor. 3:18, “...are being transformed...”

Our hope is in terms of certainty, a promise of God (Phil. 3:20-21; Col. 3:4).  
Saved for glory.

We are only in the process of getting to where we are supposed to be, Glory (Heb. 2:9-10).

Heb. 3:6, “...if we hold fast our confidence and boast of our hope firm until the end.”  
Perseverance does not save us but those who are saved will persevere.

Through trials persevere, through perseverance comes proven character (revealing the character of who you are, the son of God, trusting in Him) with this there is hope!
