**“The Impossibility of Being Separated from

Romans 8: 31-39
Part 2**

Introduction - LOVE, not our love for God but God’s love for us (Jer. 31:3, 2 Tim. 1:12).
God saved us to glory forever.

Body: Psalm 91: 1-4 and Hebrews 7:24-25

Suffering, adversity does not indicate the absence of the love of God!

V. 36, quotation from Psalm 44, “For your sake we are being put to death all day long; we were considered as sheep to be slaughtered.” Suffering for faithfulness! By Christ’s design we are in a world of rebellion to be “like salt” and we will suffer. Suffer for Christ’s sake, for as they hated Him they will hate us also. Jesus suffered all those persecutions! What a privilege to suffer in a like manner (2 Cor. 4:7-11).
