Sermon Notes for January 3, 1993

“There is a God in Heaven”
Daniel 2
Part 3

- I. The God of heaven sends a dream. (2:1-13)
- II. The God of heaven reveals a dream. (2:14-35)
 - A. Daniel requests time. (2:14-16)
 - B. Daniel requests compassion. (2:17-23)
 - C. Daniel requests an audience. (2:24-35)
- III. The God of heaven interprets the dream. (2:36-49)
 - A. The four metals symbolize four successive kingdoms:
 - 1. Head of Gold – Babylon, Nebuchadnezzar
 - 2. Chest and arms of silver – Medo-Persia
 - 3. Abdomen and thighs of bronze – Greece
 - 4. Legs of iron and feet mixed with clay – Rome
 - B. The final form of the Roman empire would consist of a transition into 10 kingdoms. (cf 7:24; Rev. 17:12)
 - C. The stone cut out of a mountain without hands refers to Jesus’ coming.
