Sermon Notes for November 25-26, 1995 "A Christians Duty in a Hostile World" 1 Peter 8:7-11

What do we learn about <u>duty</u> in this passage?
The <u>INCENTIVE</u> "The end of all things is at hand"
"end" (TELOS) - <u>Fulfillment or Consummation</u>
The "end of all things" - Is the day when the living as well as the dead who are in Christ are gathered together with Him and given their glorified bodies (I Thess. 4:13-17)
"at hand" (ENGGIKEN) - Communicates "immanency" or in other words there are <u>no other events</u> that we need to look for before the "end of all things"
We must therefore live in <u>expectancy</u>
The <u>INSTRUCTIONS</u>
Duties to the One above (I Peter 4:7) - Prayer
"sound judgment" (SOPHRONESATE) - <u>clear thinking</u>
"Sober Spirit" (NEPSATE) - <u>Free of intoxication</u>
Duties to one another (I Peter 4:8-11)

We are to <u>fervently love</u> one another (I Peter 4:8)
"covers a multitude of sins"
It doesn't mean that we can <u>ignore</u> sin
(Matthew 18:15-17, Titus 3:10-11)
It means that we must <u>forgive</u> sin
(Proverbs 10:12)
"be hospitable to one another" - <u>Love of Strangers</u>
"employ it in serving one another" - <u>Service</u>
Spiritual gift - It is whatever <u>capacity</u> that the Lord has graciously <u>given</u> us in order to <u>minister</u> to the church.
The issue is not what we do but rather getting about doing what we do as good stewards.
The <u>INTENTIONS</u>
What is the ultimate goal of the exercising of the gifts? The Glory of God (I Peter 4:11)
Speaking gifts - By being conscious that what he is saying is God's message for the occasion.
Serving gifts - By being conscious that what he is doing is in God's strength.
