An <u>elect</u> people (1 Thessalonians 1:1-4)

Choice (EKLEGO) - Denotes a picking out.

What characterizes the <u>chosen</u> or <u>elect?</u> (1 Thessalonians 1:3)

- 1. A faith that works
- 2. A <u>love</u> that <u>labors</u>
- 3. A <u>hope</u> that <u>perseveres</u>

An exemplary people (1 Thessalonians 1:5-7)

They received the Word (1 Thessalonians 1:5)

They <u>followed</u> their spiritual leaders (1 Thessalonians 1:6)

They encouraged other churches (1 Thessalonians 1:7)

An <u>enthusiastic</u> people (1 Thessalonians 1:8)

"sounded forth" means "to trumpet"

They were as eager to <u>proclaim</u> the Word as they were to <u>receive</u> the Word.

An <u>expectant</u> people (1 Thessalonians 1:9-10)

Expecting the Lord's return is:

A motivation for <u>soul winning</u>(1 Thessalonians 2:19-20)

A motivation for <u>stable living</u>(1 Thessalonians 3:11-13)

A comfort in <u>sorrow</u> (1 Thessalonians 4:13-18)

An encouragement for godly living (1 Thessalonians 5:23-24)
