Paul was thankful for his memories.
Paul was thankful for their <u>participation</u> (KOINONIA) in the <u>gospel</u> .
Paul was thankful that the <u>work</u> which was begun in them will be <u>completed</u> .
Paul was <u>assured</u> that the work of <u>salvation</u> begun in them would be completed.
How <u>important</u> is the assurance of salvation in respect to ourselves and others?
When the cruise line posted a one word status report of each passenger all that mattered were the words "saved" or "lost."
I would propose to you that in the end all that will really matter are these two words: <u>saved</u> or <u>lost</u> . How important is the assurance of salvation in respect to ourselves and others? Being assured that we and the people around us will not <u>slip</u> into the abyss of God's <u>final judgment</u> far exceeds anything that this <u>world</u> has to offer.
Paul, because of their <u>participation</u> (KOINONIA) in the gospel from "the first day until now" was <u>assured</u> that they were in fact <u>saved</u> (Philippians 1:3-5).
Paul was confident that their participation in the gospel would continue because he saw it is a continuing expression of God's ongoing work of salvation (Philippians 1:6)

Paul was confident that the Lord was at work in the Philippians and would complete that work in the Philippians not in <u>spite</u> of their conduct but <u>because</u> of their conduct.

God's work in respect to His church will be over on the "Day of Jesus Christ." The Day of Christ Jesus relates wholly to the <u>reward</u> and <u>blessing</u> of the <u>saints</u> at His <u>coming</u> (1 Corinthians 1:8; 5:5; 2 Corinthians 1:14; Philippians 1:6, 10; 2:16).

The Day of Christ Jesus is our <u>finish</u> line. Everything that we have been striving for with our fellow Christians will finally be <u>realized</u>.
