Why did Paul pray what he prayed?
First of all he prayed what he prayed in order that they might "approve the things that are excellent
The word "approve" (DOKIMAZO) means to "put to the test, examine."
The word "excellent" (DIAPHERO) comes from a Greek word that means "to differ." In this context it would mean that we are to discover those things which differ by surpassing others.
Paul is praying that their love would abound more and more in real knowledge and all discernment so that as they approve or test all their options they would be able to identify the option that would surpass all other options in value.
Hopefully you are here this weekend because you could not think of a better way for your <u>love</u> of God to be expressed at this moment in time than to be sitting here with your brothers and sisters in Christ praising God and seeking to learn and apply His Word.

Paul wanted the Philippians not only to approve the things that were excellent but to consistently <u>choose</u> the things that were excellent and this consistent <u>choosing</u> would lead them to be sincere and blameless until the day of Christ.
