"Good Results from Bad Circumstances"

Philippians 1:18-26

The third circumstance God used to advance the gospel was Paul's <u>crisis</u> (Philippians 1:18b-26).
Paul in effect is saying in Philippians 1:18, "The gospel is advancing in the midst of my <u>present</u> circumstances and I am rejoicing. And I will continue to rejoice in my <u>future</u> circumstances as my present crises unfolds."
We need to know that Paul's anticipated future joy comes from his <u>assurance</u> of ultimate <u>salvation</u> .
The word "deliverance" (SOTERIA) is commonly used in the New Testament, and especially in Paul's letters, to mean "salvation" in the ultimate sense of rescue from God's wrath on the final day.
Paul quoting <u>Job 13:16</u> is strong evidence that Paul uses the word "deliverance" in Philippians 1:19 to communicate his final <u>vindication</u> before God.
