"The Church of Christ"

Colossians 1:24-29

1. The Church's Challenge (1:24)

a. Our disposition: To rejoice in suffering

b. Our contribution: To share in suffering

Christ's afflictions refer to the sufferings of the <u>church</u>, the body of Christ (cf. Acts 9:4). The word "afflictions" (THLIPSIS) is used in the New Testament to mean the <u>trials</u> in <u>life</u>, never the <u>death</u> of <u>Christ</u>. The context is <u>service</u>, not <u>salvation</u>. What is lacking is not in regard to the <u>atonement</u> of our sin, but in regard to <u>fulfillment</u> of the <u>ministry</u> of the church.

2. The Church's Character (1:25-27)

a. The church is developing

"Fully carry out" (PLEROSAI) has the sense of doing something to its completion.

The church, of which Paul was made a servant, has been entrusted with the Scripture and we are ministering the Word of God to accomplish its ultimate fulfillment.

b. The church is distinct

In the New Testament, a mystery (MUSTERION) is not something that is a <u>puzzle</u> to figure out, but is rather something that is <u>hidden</u>, unable to be known until the time when God <u>reveals</u> it.

c. The church is diverse

Believing <u>Jews</u> are joined with believing <u>Gentiles</u> into one entity, the body of Christ (Ephesians 2:11-16).

d. The church is the dwelling of God

It is God's will to make Himself known <u>among</u> the Gentiles by dwelling <u>in</u> believers.
3. The Church's <u>Commission</u> (1:28-29) The keywords in Colossians 1:28 are <u>we</u> and <u>every</u> .
a. The Charge: <u>Proclaim</u> Christ
b. The Correction: <u>Admonish</u> and <u>teach</u>
c. The Communication: Wisdom of Christ
d. The Culmination: <u>Maturity</u> in Christ

e. The Commitment: <u>Labor</u> for Christ
