Sermon Notes for October 16-17, 2004

"The Defense of the Church"

1 Timothy 4:1-9

1. The Demonic Cause of the Attack (4:1)

The word for "times" is plural and means "seasons" or "eras." As the seasons come and go and return again, so the demonic doctrines will continue to come around to us in the future.

The demonic target: <u>desertion</u> (2 Timothy 4:3-4)

The demonic technique: deceit (John 8:44)

The demonic tool: doctrine (2 Corinthians 11:3)

Our beliefs dictate our behavior.

2. The Deceitful Course of the Attack (4:2)

Demons work through people (2 Corinthians 11:13).

The telltale sign of the devil's agents is their inability to <u>perceive</u> their own <u>double-standard</u>.

3. The Destructive Content of the Attack (4:3-5)

Our faith is attacked when we believe that <u>abstaining</u> from what God has created is a means of <u>godliness</u> (4:3).

Rather than <u>avoiding</u> what God has created, we must <u>use</u> what God has created for His purpose, with thankfulness (4:4-5).

4. The Disciplined Confrontation of the Attack (4:6-8)

a. Point out <u>fabrications</u>

We improve our ministry through our teaching.

Christ's servants speak up for truth (Matthew 16:11-12).

b. Provide with feeding

We improve our <u>teaching</u> through <u>learning</u>.

Christ's servants seek out the truth (Matthew 4:4).

c. Put out <u>fables</u>

We improve our learning through discernment.

Christ's servants shun error (1 Timothy 1:4).

d. Plan for the future

We improve our <u>discernment</u> through <u>discipline</u>.

The Greek word for discipline gives us our English word "gymnastics."

Christ's servants strive for godliness (Proverbs 6:6-11).

Godliness is more profitable <u>now</u> and <u>later</u>.

5. The Desired Consent Against the Attack (4:9)

The disciplined opposition to the devil's desire for people to fall away from faith is the responsibility of <u>everyone</u>.
