"The Condemnation of False Teachers"

2 Peter 2:4-10

- 2 Peter 1 focuses on God's Word of truth.
- 2 Peter 2 focuses on God's wrath on false teachers.

The Old Testament was given as an example to warn us regarding sin (1 Corinthians 10:6).

The Old Testament was also given for <u>instruction</u> to give us <u>hope</u> (Romans 15:4).

- 1. Divine destruction in the past (2:4-6)
- a. The judgment of <u>fallen angels</u> (2:4)

Most angels are <u>holy</u>, but some chose <u>evil</u> (Revelation 12:4).

Some evil angels are loose and some are bound.

All evil angels are destined for eternal judgment (Revelation 20).

There is no plan of <u>redemption</u> for fallen angels.

b. The judgment of the <u>ancient world</u> (2:5)

God is able to bring world-wide judgment.

Noah not only believed God (Hebrews 11:7), he proclaimed that belief to the world.

c. The judgment of Sodom and Gomorrah (2:6)

God is able to bring specific judgment on certain places.

One of God's purposes in judgment is to warn by example.

- 2. Divine deliverance in the past (2:7-8)
- a. Lot's <u>rescue</u>
 - God's grace sends messengers to warn us
 - God's grace sends messengers to deliver us
- b. Lot's <u>righteousness</u>
- c. Lot's resistance
- d. Lot's relatives

- 3. Determined destiny in the future (2:9-10)
- a. The <u>target</u> of God's judgment: He knows <u>who</u>
 - Those who indulge the <u>flesh</u>
 - Those who despise <u>authority</u>
- b. The <u>timing</u> of God in judgment: He knows <u>when</u>
 - Their present punishment (Romans 1:27)
 - Their <u>future</u> punishment (Luke 16:23)
 - Their <u>eternal</u> punishment (Revelation 20:11-15)
- c. The threat of God's judgment: He knows how
 - The <u>rescue</u> of the godly
 - The <u>retribution</u> on the ungodly
