## "Remembering God's Wrath"

#### 2 Peter 3:1-7

#### 1. God's Word stirs up man (3:1-2)

a. God's Word through Peter (3:1)

Peter's first letter is the book of 1 Peter.

The purpose of 2 Peter is to stir up by way of <u>reminder</u>, which assumes a <u>prior knowledge</u>. "Sincere" assumes a desire to obey.

- b. God's words through the <u>prophets</u> (3:2)
- c. God's words through the <u>apostles</u> (3:2)

### 2. Man's words scoff at God (3:3-4)

- a. The mockers are promised
- b. Their motive is their <u>passion</u>
- c. Their mocking is <u>presumptuous</u>
- 1) They doubt God's integrity
- 2) They disregard God's intervention

One of the most common errors that people make is assuming that everything will remain the same.

#### 3. God's Word has shaped the earth (3:5)

Those who fail to recognize God in creation do so deliberately.

It is by <u>faith</u> that we know God's Word created the world (Hebrews 11:3).

Belief in God includes a belief in <u>creationism</u>. The reference to the formation of the earth out of water and by water is based on <u>Genesis 1:1-10</u>.

#### 4. God's Word has swamped the earth (3:6)

God created by water and God destroyed by water.

Belief in God includes belief in a universal flood.

## 5. God's Word will smoke the earth (3:7)

- a. The coming judgment has a greater wrath
- 1) The scope of the wrath
- 2) The span of the wrath
- 3) The subjects of the wrath
- b. The coming judgment has a greater warning

As with the judgment of the flood, the warning is to God's <u>people</u>. People must be warned to <u>flee</u> from the wrath to come (Matthew 3:7).
