**Sermon Notes for July 22-23, 2006**

**"Loving One Another"**

**John 13:34-35**

The first factor that would be fundamental in shaping the course of their immediate future was a new glory (John 13:31-32).

The second factor that would be fundamental in shaping the course of their immediate future was a new situation (John 13:33).

The third factor that would be fundamental in shaping the course of their immediate future was a new commandment (John 13:34-35).

The new commandment that Christ gave His disciples was that they would love one another as He had loved them (John 13:34).

In loving one another as Christ loved His disciples, how might our love for one another be manifested?

Loving one another as Christ loved His disciples will be manifested by the high priority we place on getting together with our church family (Mt. 16:24).

Loving one another as Christ loved His disciples will be manifested by the high priority we place on sacrificially serving our church family (John 10:11-15).

Loving one another as Christ loved His disciples will be manifested by the way we care for our church family when we are compelled for righteous reasons to separate from them (John 13-17).

May God give us the grace to love our church family in the same way as Christ loved His disciples.
