Valley Bible Church Sermon Notes for May 25, 2008

Christ Before Pilate John 18:28-38 Dale Whitehead

Pilate meets with Christ's accusers (18:28-32).

Pilate's initial examination of Christ (John 18:33-38).

When Pilate asked Jesus if He was the King of the Jews, he was asking Jesus if He was their King in a <u>political</u> sense.

When Pilate asked Jesus, "Are you the King of the Jews?" he was not so much asking a question as much as he was expressing <u>disbelief</u>.

Rather than seeing a man that in anyway fit his <u>image</u> of what a king, a political king, might look like, he saw only a rather unimpressive man without any trappings of regal authority or power.

Christ used Pilate's initial question of disbelief to seize <u>control</u> of the trial by asking Pilate a question of His own in John 18:34.

When Pilate, in response to Christ's question, chose to abandon the examination of the Jewish charges in John 18:35 by asking Christ "What have You done?" it provided the opportunity for Christ to explain the true <u>nature</u> of His kingship.

Christ begins by explaining what His kingdom was not (John 18:36).

When Jesus said that His kingdom was not of this world, He meant that His kingdom did not <u>originate</u> in this world nor did it <u>belong</u> to this world.

When Pilate responded to what Christ had said about what His kingdom was not with the words, "So You are a king?" Pilate was inviting Jesus to <u>expand</u> on the nature of His kingdom.

We learn that Christ's kingdom originated from above (John 18:37).

We learn that Christ's kingdom is based on <u>truth</u> as revealed in and through Christ (John 18:37).

We learn that Christ's true disciples are identified by the way they <u>respond</u> to the truth as Christ Himself had revealed it (John 18:37).
