Revelation 7:9-17

1. John shares a description of this great multitude (Revelation 7:9-10).
 - a. He describes the amount of those in this great multitude.
 - b. He describes the ancestry of this great multitude.
 - c. He describes the assembly of this great multitude.
 - d. He describes the appearance of this great multitude.
 - e. He describes the action of this great multitude.
2. John shares the association with this great multitude (Revelation 7:11-12).
 - a. Notice the associates of the great multitude.
 - b. Notice the adoration of the great multitude.
3. John shares the origination of this great multitude (Revelation 7:13-14).
 - a. Notice the elder’s request.
 - b. Notice John’s reply.

- c. Notice the elder's response.

- 4. John shares the provision for this great multitude (Revelation 7:15-17).
 - a. God provides the great multitude with an opportunity for service.

 - b. God provides the great multitude with safety.

 - c. God provides the great multitude with shepherding.

So, what should our response be to John's vision of the great multitude in Revelation 7:9-17?

1-We should forge on in our discipleship of others (Matthew 28:19-20).

2-We should focus on our devotion to God (Romans 12:1).

3-We should be filled with a desire for our future hope (Titus 2:13).
