Sermon Notes for April 29, 2012

An Unusual Vision
Revelation 10:1-11

These verses serve as a parenthesis between the sixth and seventh trumpet judgments. This parenthetical section begins here in Revelation 10:1 and continues through Revelation 11:14.

Here in Revelation 10, John details the opening events of this parenthesis by describing 5 unusual features to this vision.

- I. John describes an unusual angel (Revelation 10:1-2).
 - A. John speaks of the descending of this angel.
 - B. John shares the description of this angel.
- II. John describes an unusual act (Revelation 10:2-3).
 - A. Notice where this strong angel stands.
 - B. Notice how this strong angel sounds.
- III. John describes an unusual answer (Revelation 10:3-4).
 - A. Notice the declaration that is made.
 - B. Notice the directive that is mandated.
- IV. John describes an unusual announcement (Revelation 10:5-7).
 - A. The style of this announcement
 - B. The substance of this announcement
- V. John describes an unusual assignment (Revelation 10:8-11).
 - A. The command to procure
 - B. The command to partake
 - C. The command to prophesy
