Sermon Notes for December 23, 2012

A Child is Born
Revelation 12:5-6

I. The delivery of a son (Revelation 12:5).

A. The Son's Incarnation:

1. The incarnation is prophesied in the Old Testament (Genesis 3:15; 49:10; Isaiah 7:14; 9:6-7; Micah 5:2).
2. The incarnation is proclaimed in the New Testament (Matthew 1:18-25; Luke 1:26-35; 2:1-20).

B. The Son's Coronation:

1. The coronation is referenced in the Old Testament (Psalm 2:7-9).
2. The coronation is relayed in the New Testament (Revelation 19:11-21).

C. The Son's Exaltation:

1. The exaltation includes His ascension (Luke 24:50-51; Acts 1:9-11).
2. The exaltation involves His enthronement (Acts 2:24-25; Revelation 5).
