**Sermon Notes for September 21, 2014**

**Prelude to the Last Plagues**  
**Revelation 15:1-4**

In Revelation 15:1-4, John provides a needed introduction to the final phase of God's eschatological wrath that should motivate us to live in joyful anticipation of our future hope.

I. We are invited to look at the scene of this vision (Revelation 15:1-2).

A. John sees a sign (Revelation 15:1).

1. Notice the place of this sign.
2. Notice the portrayal of this sign.
3. Notice the participation in this sign.

B. John sees a sea (Revelation 15:2).

1. He describes it as looking like glass.
2. He describes it as mixed with fire.

C. John sees the saints (Revelation 15:2).

1. These saints are standing as conquerors.
2. These saints are standing in a chorus.

II. We are invited to listen to the song of this vision (Revelation 15:3-4).

A. Part One: The content of praise (Revelation 15:3-4).

1. God's works are great!

2. God's ways are good!

3. God's name is glorious!

B. Part Two: The cause of praise (Revelation 15:4).

1. God's constant worth

2. God's coming worship

3. God's certain wrath
