The Crucified and Risen Christ
Isaiah 53:10-12

The prophesied blessings for Christ resulting from His predicted death in Isaiah 53:10-12 pointed to His future resurrection.

The blessing prophesied in Isaiah 53:10, that Christ would see His future offspring, pointed to His resurrection.

The blessing prophesied in Isaiah 53:10, that the days of Christ would be prolonged, pointed to His resurrection.

The blessing prophesied in Isaiah 53:10, that the counsel of God would prosper in His hand, pointed to His resurrection.

The blessing prophesied in Isaiah 53:11, that Christ would see the fruit of His death and be satisfied, pointed to His resurrection.

The prophesied blessing in Isaiah 53:12, that Christ would “divide the booty with the strong,” pointed to His resurrection.

May God give us the grace to view the resurrection of Christ as an established historical fact so that we might be continuously reassured of our salvation through Christ.
