Sermon Notes for December 29, 2019

The Final Warning of Hebrews
Hebrews 12:25-29

The warning begins with a command to professing believers “to see to it” that they do not refuse to listen to Him who is speaking (Hebrews 12:25a).

The author made it clear to his readers in Hebrews 1:1-2 that God the Father was now speaking to them “in His Son” (Hebrews 1:1-2).

Professing believers who refuse to listen to God when He is speaking to them in His Son from Mount Zion will not escape the judgment of God (Hebrews 12:25b-27 cf. Hebrews 10:28-29).

The first event that the author highlighted in Hebrews 12:26 is the future shaking of the earth and the heavens as prophesied in Haggai 2:6 (cf. Revelation 16:17-21).

The second event that the author highlighted in Hebrews 12:27 is the future fiery removal of the heavens and the earth as prophesied in 2 Peter 3:3-10.

Those who believe that they have come to Mount Zion with its many blessings should offer up to God a life of acceptable worship (Hebrews 12:28-29 cf. Romans 12:1).

May we by the grace of God continue to listen to Him as He speaks to us in His Son that we might know that we have come to Mount Zion and will be protected from God’s final judgment.
