What is the significance of the phrase "having been wrought in God" in respect to the response of various people to the light?

### **Applying the sermon**

If God sent His Son into this world to save sinners and not to judge them, how might this impact how we relate to each other?

How does knowing that the unsaved are already judged and are simply awaiting the final execution of their sentence motivate you in your personal outreach?

What are the most common things that hinder people from coming to Christ?

What do you see in your life that assures you that you are one of those who have chosen to come to the light?
