Why is it so serious for someone to disturb a church (5:12)?

Applying the sermon

Think of a time when you encountered someone advocating their personal opinion to be the moral standard for others. How could that have had a negative affect on others?

How big of a problem did you see this judgment of others to be?

How did you respond when you saw the person erect a non-moral standard for others?

What are the challenges that you face when you encounter teaching that disturbs people with a false moral code?

What can you do when you see people who judge others by non-biblical standards?
