“A Change in Plans”
2 Corinthians 1:12-14

Observing the text

Read 2 Corinthians 1:12-14 carefully and make as many observations as possible.

How do these verses fit in with what has come before?

Why did Paul appeal to conscience?

Why did Paul tell the Corinthians that he wrote nothing else to them other than what they read and understood in verse 13?

What is “the day of our Lord Jesus” that Paul refers to in verse 14?

Applying the sermon

Is your conscience accusing you in any area of your life?

Are you ignoring its warning?

What do you need to do in order to clear your conscience?

Has anyone spoken to you about any perceived fault or sin in your life? How did you respond? Did you take the time to prayerfully reflect on what they said and allow time for your conscience to either accuse you or to rise up and defend you?
