2 Corinthians 1:15-17

Observing the text

Read 2 Corinthians 1:15-22 carefully and make as many observations as possible.

How do these verses fit in with the flow of the passage?

What did Paul mean when he said that he was “not vacillating” in verse 17?

What did Paul mean when he said that what he had preached was “yes in Him.”

What is the significance of God giving Paul and the Corinthians the Spirit as a pledge in verse 22?

Applying the sermon

Are there any areas of your life where others might be able to righteously bring an accusation against you?

Are you living your life in such an exemplary manner that if an accusation was brought against you falsely, others would be able to say that the accusations are not consistent with the person that they have come to know?

What areas of your life do you believe could be strengthened and lived in an even more exemplary manner?

What are some steps you can take to strengthen yourself in these areas?
