Study Aid for the Sermon from June 21, 2009 “Act Like Men, Be Strong” 1 Corinthians 16:13-14

Observing the text

Read 1 Corinthians 16:13-14 and make as many observations as possible.

What did Paul mean when he told the Corinthians to be on the “alert?”

What did Paul mean when he told the Corinthians to “stand firm in the faith?”

What did Paul mean when he said to “act like men?”

What did Paul mean when he said to “be strong?”

What did Paul mean when he said “let all that you do be done in love?”

Applying the sermon

What do you believe is molding and shaping your life?

Is your life being shaped by the world, by the flesh, by the devil or by the Word of God?

If your life is being shaped by the Word of God, in what ways has it made your life more difficult? Would you describe yourself in those situations as acting courageously?

Do you believe that you are seeking to live your life in your strength that God provides? Can you support this statement by the love you manifest in everything that you do?
