Observing the text

Read 2 Corinthians 3:1-3 and makes as many observations as possible.

How does this fit in with what has come before?

What did Paul mean when he said that the Corinthians were his letter?

What did Paul mean when he said that they were known and read of all men?

What was the significance of the letter being written on their hearts?

Applying the sermon

What is more important in determining if someone is an effective minister, their degrees and letters of recommendation or the changed lives of people whom they have ministered to?

Do you consider yourself an effective minister? Why?

Who has been positively impacted by your proclamation of the gospel of Christ and the ministry of His Word, who are your living, breathing letters of commendation?
