“No Quitting!”
2 Corinthians 4:13-15

Observing the text

Read 2 Corinthians 4:13-15 carefully and make as many observations as possible. How do these verses fit into the flow of the passage?

Why did Paul introduce the hope of the resurrection to his readers?

What did Paul mean when he told the Corinthians that all things were for their sake?

What did Paul see coming as a result of his ministry to the Corinthians?

Applying the sermon

What do you believe about the resurrection of the righteous?

How certain are you that you will participate in that resurrection and why?

Do you think it is possible for a person to believe in the resurrection with a high degree of certainty and not have it impact their life?

Has the certainty of your future resurrection impacted the way you are presently living your life? Has it impacted your sharing of the gospel?

Is the present contemplation of your resurrection with all of its implications dominating your thoughts and your energies, or is your future earthly retirement dominating your thoughts and energies?
