

## *Valley Bible Church - Sermon Study Questions*

### **Study Aid for the Sermon from May 9, 2010 “Christian Parenting” Deuteronomy 6:4-9**

#### **Observing the text**

Read Deuteronomy 6:4-9 carefully and make as many observations as possible.

What is the significance of the phrase “shall be on your heart” in Deuteronomy 6:6?

What was the expected consequence of having the commandments of God on their hearts?

What did Moses mean when he said, “You shall bind them as a sign on your hand and they shall be as frontals on your forehead?”

What did Moses mean when he said, “You shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates?”

#### **Applying the sermon**

As a parent, what is your present overarching goal for your children?

What is your strategy for achieving this primary goal?

What should be your attitude in this pursuit?

In light of the truths that were presented this morning, what, if anything, do you believe needs to be changed in respect to your parental goal, strategy, or attitude?

In light of your previous answer, take the time to come before God and ask Him to pour out His grace upon you so that your children might be blessed and that He might be glorified.
