Study Aid for the Sermon from June 6, 2010
“Paul’s Driving Motivations”
2 Corinthians 5:11-13

Observing the text

Carefully read 2 Corinthians 5:11-13 and make as many observations as possible.

How do these verses fit into the flow of the passage?

What does Paul mean by “knowing the fear of the Lord?”

How does the fear of the Lord relate to persuading men?

How does the persuading of men relate to what Paul says in verses 12-13?

Applying the sermon

Explain how being warned by God that He will not be mocked and that He will be our judge should cause us to fear Him.

Do you believe that you have a healthy fear of the Lord? How has that fear impacted the way you are choosing to live your life?

Why should you be concerned if your choices in life do not consistently manifest a healthy fear of the Lord?

Can you say with confidence that one of your primary driving forces is your fear of God? How is that manifested?

If you are unable to say this with confidence take the time now to pray and ask God for the grace to not only see Him as your savior but also as your judge.
