Study Aid for the Sermon from September 12, 2010 “Living Reconciled” 2 Corinthians 6:6-7

Observing the text

Read 2 Corinthians 6:6-7 and make as many observations as possible.

How do these verses fit into the flow of the passage?

What is the difference between “in knowledge” and “in the word of truth?”

What did Paul mean by the phrase “in the Holy Spirit?”

What did Paul mean by the phrase “by the weapons of righteousness for the right hand and the left?”

Applying the sermon

In what ways are you encouraged or discouraged when you, as a minister of reconciliation, compare the manner of your “enduring” to the manner of Paul’s “enduring?”

As you consider the manner of your enduring could you say with Paul that “in everything” you have commended yourself as a “servant of God?”

What are the specific areas that need to be strengthened?

How can you strengthen those areas that you believe need attention?

Take time to pray, acknowledging your weakness and asking God for His strength to do the things that you believe need to be done.
