Study Aid for the Sermon from October 17, 2010
“Do Not Be Bound Together With Unbelievers”
2 Corinthians 6:14

Observing the text

Read 2 Corinthians 6:14-7:1 carefully and make as many observations as possible.

How do these verses fit into the flow of the passage?

Who are the unbelievers Paul is referring to in 2 Corinthians 6:14?

What does it mean to “not be bound together with unbelievers?”

What questions did Paul ask to drive home the theology of separation?

Applying the sermon

What unbelievers are you presently interacting with?

Do you see those unbelievers primarily as your mission field or primarily as your friends?

In what way is any present relationship with an unbeliever undermining your devotion to Christ, hindering your service to Christ, or diminishing your attachment to the body of Christ?

Would you be willing to give up that relationship if necessary?

How committed are you in praying for our church leaders that they might be able to discern any threats to our fellowship by unbelievers who presently may be in our midst?
