Study Aid for the Sermon from May 13, 2012 The Heart of Christian Parenting Deuteronomy 6:4-9

Observing the text

Read Deuteronomy 6:4-9 carefully and make as many observations as possible.

In Deuteronomy 6:6, what is the significance of the phrase “shall be on your heart?”

What was the expected consequence of having the commandments of God on their hearts?

What did Moses mean when he said, “You shall bind them as a sign on your hand and they shall be as frontals on your forehead?”

What did Moses mean when he said, “You shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates?”

Applying the sermon

What values and beliefs are you trying to pass along to your children?

How are you showing that your belief in Christ and what He has accomplished through His death on the cross is the most important thing to communicate to our children?

In what specific ways by your supreme love for God and His word have you put your children in the very best position possible to exercise faith in Him?

If you have fallen short, then confess your sin and by the grace of God make the adjustments you need to make, so not only would your children be blessed, but that God might be glorified.
