Study Aid for the Sermon from September 9, 2012 Paul's Final Appeal To The Unrepentant 2 Corinthians 13:7-10

Observing the text

Read 2 Corinthians 13:7-10 and make as many observations as possible. How do these verses fit into the flow of 2 Corinthians 13:1-10?

What did Paul pray for in 2 Corinthians 13:7?

How might Paul's prayer in 2 Corinthians 13:7 leave him appearing "unapproved?"

How might Paul's appearance as "unapproved" relate to the Corinthians being "made complete?"

When Paul said, "I am writing these things" what was he referring to?

Applying the sermon

Do you believe that we need to be involved in the work of intercessory prayer?

If you are involved in intercessory prayer, who and what are you praying for?

As you look at your list of what you are praying for, is your list focused on the material and circumstantial or is it focused on the spiritual and the eternal? How would your prayer affect the spiritual life of our church?

Take a moment, as the servant of God and in response to the word of God, to commit yourself to become a faithful intercessor on behalf of this church and the individual members that make up this church.
