Observing the text

Read Hebrews 1:1-4 and make as many observations as possible.

Do these verses provide us with any clues concerning who wrote this book, to whom he wrote it, from whence he wrote it, or why?

Are these opening verses structured differently from most other New Testament epistles?

Read Hebrews 13:20-25 and make as many observations as possible.

Do these verses provide us any further clues concerning who wrote this book, to whom he wrote it, from whence he wrote it, or why?

Applying the sermon

Can you think of any professing believers whom you know that are no longer practicing their faith? Who are they?

What happened to them? What were the forces operating in their lives that led to their discouragement?

How could the same forces be at work in the lives of people presently attending our church?

In what way might you be in danger of falling away from the faith?

What is there in your life that is presently giving you assurance of salvation?
