Study Aid for the Sermon from May 26, 2013 Christ is Superior to the Prophets Hebrews 1:3

Read Hebrews 1:1-4 and make as many observations as possible.

How does the phrase “when He had made purification of sins” fit into the flow of the passage?

What does the word “purification” mean?

Why is the purification of sins so important?

Applying the sermon

How would taking God’s wrath seriously cause people to be more concerned about their sin and about being purified from their sin?

What did God do in order to propitiate or to satisfy His wrath so that individuals might be spared from it?

Do you believe that the benefit of God giving up His Son to death to pay the debt of our sin can be enjoyed by us apart from personal faith, or in other words apart from us transferring our trust from ourselves and our good works to Jesus Christ alone for our salvation?

If you have taken advantage of what God has done for you when He gave up His Son to death, when did you do this and how has this changed your life? Take this time now to thank God for His love for you.

If you have not, then take this time and ask God for the grace to believe, so that you might transfer your trust from yourself to Jesus Christ alone for your salvation.
