What is the response of the people of the world to this beast from the sea as recorded in Revelation 13:8?

What clarification has been made as to the identity of those who dwell on the earth in Revelation 13:8?

What is being taught in the proverb that concludes the passage in Revelation 13:9-10?

Applying the sermon

What struggles, conflicts or persecution are you presently facing? How does an understanding of this passage help you to see the spiritual battle at hand?

According to Ephesians 6:10-17, what tools as a believer have you been given to face this spiritual battle? What can you change in your personal life in order to better utilize these tools?

Do you know whose names are written in the book of life of the Lamb who has been slain? As a believer, what is your personal responsibility toward other people with whom you cross paths?

Can you be described as persevering and full of faith? What can you do or change in your life in order to be characterized in such a way?
