Study Aid for the Sermon from July 28, 2013 Christ is Superior to the Angels Hebrews 1:5

Observing the text

Read Hebrews 1:5-14 and note every reference to angels.

How does Hebrews 1:5 fit into the flow of the chapter?

What is the author trying to accomplish in verse 5?

What does it mean when it says, "I have begotten you?"

What does it mean when it refers to "today?"

What does "I will be a Father to Him" mean? What would be the timing of that?

Applying the sermon

Because Christ is God's unique Son and should be esteemed more than all of God's creation, would this mean that those whom God has placed in other exalted positions among mankind should not be esteemed?

What should the balance be between how you esteem Christ and how you esteem others whom God has placed in exalted positions?

How are you maintaining this proper balance between your esteem for Christ and your esteem for others whom God has placed in exalted positions?

Pray for God's grace to see that balance better and for the grace to do better.
