Observing the text

Compare and contrast the vision given to Peter with the vision given to Cornelius

What is the significance of this vision to Peter at this point in the Book of Acts?

What are the specifics of the vision and why are they important?

Why does the author note the number of times that this happened (10:16)?

Applying the sermon

Have you ever encountered a professed follower of Christ who felt it necessary to keep certain Old Testament dietary laws? If so, how did you respond when you learned this? What would you say differently now?

Why do people have difficulty understanding the role of the Old Testament for Christians today?

Have you ever felt that certain foods were morally wrong to eat, or that certain foods were so bad that you would judge others according to the foods they ate? If so, what happened with your perspective?

What behaviors of yours do you need to rethink as you seek to bring the message of Christ to unbelievers?
