**Study Aid for the Sermon from November 3, 2013  
The Visit By Peter To Cornelius  
Acts 10:17-33**

**Observing the text**

Why was additional revelation given to Peter by the Spirit of God (10:19-20)?

Who gathered in Caesarea and why is this important (10:23-24; cf. 11:12)?

Why would Jews have considered men like Cornelius to be unclean?

Why does Luke include so much repetitive detail (10:30-33)?

**Applying the sermon**

How have you experienced God's working concurrently in your life and in the lives of others? How does this experience serve your faith in our Lord?

When you were first introduced to faith in Christ, how did you involve your family and friends?

How are you currently being used by God as his instrument to bring others to the knowledge of Christ?

As you consider your life, are there people that you find yourself lacking in desire to associate with? Why is this? What is God's perspective about this?

What can you do to increase your connection with unbelievers who might be interested in following Christ?
