“Peace in a Box of Chocolate”
2 Thessalonians 3:16

Observing the text

Skim through Second Thessalonians, and find four prayers of Paul for the believers in Thessalonica, and think about why Paul prayed these prayers.

Read 2 Thessalonians 3:16 carefully. What is the emphasis of this prayer?

Who is “the Lord of peace?”

When is this peace available?

Why did believers in Thessalonica need this peace?

Applying the sermon

What brings peace in your life?

Why is the work and person of Christ the key for having this peace in your life?

Consider what breaks the possession of this peace in your life. How can you have peace unceasingly?

What confidence do you have that you have peace in your life from the Lord?

What can you do to make sure that your life is filled with peace?
