Study Aid for the Sermon from March 16, 2014 Christ is Superior to Moses Hebrews 3:7-9

Observing the text

Read Hebrews 3:7-9 carefully and make as many observations as possible. How do these verses fit into the flow of the text?

What is the significance of the phrase, “just as the Holy Spirit says...?”

Why did the author then quote Psalms 95:7-11 in Hebrews 3:7-11?

What did the Psalmist command his readers to do based on Hebrews 3:7?

What did the Psalmist command his readers not to do based on Hebrews 3:8?

What historical period of time did the author draw upon to make his point in Hebrews 3:8-9?

Applying the sermon

How well were the Israelites walking in obedience to God when the exodus from Egypt began? When the exodus ended?

If a person ceases from following Christ as an expression of unbelief, why would you consider them in grave danger?

What are your present temptations and trials? Are you, in the midst of these temptations and trials, still striving to do the will and work of Christ?

If you are, then take time to thank God. However, if you are not, then take the time to confess your sin and ask God for the grace to do better.
